Beaufort County

Beaufort County Health Department **\$1,500**

- ❖ Establish a local coalition to address the problem of physical inactivity.

Caldwell County

Caldwell County Bikeway Project **\$1,500**

- ❖ Develop a master plan for creating bikeways/pedestrian trails in Caldwell County. The implemented plan will guide the development of pedestrian opportunities for transportation, health, and leisure activities.

Carteret County

Carteret County Parks and Recreation and Alliance for Wellness **\$1,500**

- ❖ Establish and develop a physical activity task force to assess and map existing fitness facilities and opportunities in the county, and promote the need for increased physical opportunities.

Davie County

Davie County Fitness and Nutrition Council **\$1,500**

- ❖ Promote and strengthen existing Local Fitness and Nutrition Council by recruiting more diverse members, coordinating an assessment team to look at the facilities and opportunities for physical activity in Davie County, and developing an action plan.

Jones County

Jones County Partnership **\$1,500**

- ❖ Promote physical activity opportunities through regular media coverage, promotional signs, and an amateur video of community members promoting fitness.

Lee County

Lee County Health Department **\$1,500**

- ❖ Develop and promote a Local Fitness and Nutrition Council as a subcommittee of LeeCAN, a Healthy Carolinians task force.

Montgomery County

The Montgomery Community Resource Team **\$1,500**

- ❖ Build and promote a coalition to increase community awareness of safe and well-lit places to walk. All information will be translated into Spanish to target the Hispanic population in the county.

Nash/Edgecombe County

Partners in Health: **\$1,500**

- ❖ Promote existing Local Fitness and Nutrition Council through television, newspapers, newsletters, and flyers.

New Hanover County

Wrightsville Beach Parks and Recreation Department **\$1,200**

- ❖ Research, develop, and implement a plan to provide safer walking and bicycling opportunities in Wrightsville Beach. Activities include: gathering information from bikers and walkers, taking aerial photographs, identifying right of ways, preparing for Stage II.

Brunswick County

City of Southport Parks and Recreation **\$7,500**

- ❖ Install a sandbox and jungle gym at local park to encourage and promote increased physical activity among local community residents.

Forsyth County

Be Healthy Coalition for Forsyth **\$4,120**

- ❖ Develop and install signs marking fourteen walking trails in Winston Salem communities and include signs noting historically and culturally significant sites along each trail. Promote the trails through free and paid media and existing wellness programs.

Gaston County

Gaston County Fitness and Nutrition Council **\$5,180**

- ❖ Promote the *Gaston on the Move* initiative through social marketing, media coverage, signage, a Family Fun-Run/Walk event, and training walking group leaders.

Orange County

Physical Activity Work Group (NC Office on Disability and Health) **Recognition**

- ❖ Gain support and sanction for initiatives to increase public awareness, support and opportunities for inclusive programming for people with disabilities through dissemination of best practice materials and advocacy for policy changes. Develop and coordinate a workshop in three regions of the NC Cardiovascular Health Program.

Pasquotank County

Albemarle Regional Healthy Carolinians **\$7,500**

- ❖ Build a 1.5 mile walking trail. The trail will be centrally located and extend around the entire perimeter of the hospital and community college. Trail will include signage designating distance and providing nutrition and fitness tips.

Stanly County

Stanly County Fitness Council **\$7,500**

- ❖ Use participants of the “Walk our Children to School Day” to assess the safety of the routes children use to walk to school. Use the data to advocate for environmental improvements for at least one safe route to school.

Swain County

Swain County Partnership for Health **\$7,500**

- ❖ Construct a one-mile walking trail at the Swain County Recreation Park.

Wake County

Be Active Wilmington - Easter Seals North Carolina **\$7,500**

- ❖ In the Wilmington area, survey individuals with disabilities and recreation providers to develop trainings and materials that promote inclusive physical activity programming for individuals with disabilities. Help advocate for inclusive recreation and physical activity.
