Policy Strategy Platform

- Focal point for policy action
- Created by the Eat Smart, Move More NC Policy ad hoc committee
- Includes 22 policy strategies
 - organized with frame from CDC's Community Strategies and Measurements Guide
 - state and local; legislative and organizational
- Includes passed policies
- Updated annually



Platform includes strategies to:

- Promote the availability of affordable healthy food and beverages
- Encourage breastfeeding
- Encourage physical activity or limit sedentary activity among children and youth









Platform includes strategies to:

- Create safe communities that support physical activity
- Develop capacity and support for obesity prevention







Each policy strategy:

- Organizational Action: A synthesis of organizational actions that can be taken at a state or local level.
- Legislative Action: A synthesis of recommended legislative action.
- Cost: A summary of any implementation costs identified by the task force when recommending the strategy.
- Status: Current legislative status of the policy recommendation taken directly from the North Carolina General Assembly Website.
 - **Sources:** A listing of the key North Carolina task forces that have recommended the policy strategy.
- Support: References to key sources that support the strategy.



Partners use of Platform:

- Focal point for NC policy action
- Incorporated in organizational platforms
- Educate decision makers



Platform use at local level:

- State and local policies included
- Advocate at state and local level
- Support implementation of passed policies
- State and local examples of policy issues and opportunities are needed



Next steps for Platform

- One pagers to support each policy strategy
- Enhance "alignment" with behavioral messages
- Tracking system
- Increase distribution and partners use
