The Cabarrus Health Alliance is continuing its mission to advance healthy eating in the area by bringing their mobile food market, offering fresh produce at an affordable price, to Kannapolis and Concord.

Acknowledging public awareness to the market is vital, CHA program coordinator Alicia McDaniel said. "We are here, we are accessible and friendly," she said during the first market, June 3 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Kannapolis.

"It is better quality produce and it's affordable," she said, pointing out that most of the produce is local and the markets are set up to take cash, credit, SNAP and EBT as payment similar to any grocery store. The markets are part of the CHA Racial and Ethnic Approaches to Community Health (REACH) grant to incu althe food access to minority residents.


